



The Interreg MED European project PELAGOS (<https://www.facebook.com/Pelagos-Interregmed>) aims at establishing a Transnational Mediterranean Innovative Cluster in Blue Energy (BE), which will be composed of seven (7) National networks/clusters (Hubs). Apart from Greece, the rest participating countries are Croatia, Cyprus, France, Italy, Portugal and Spain. This forthcoming Cluster will be properly designed in order to accelerate the development of BE in insular and coastal regions of the Mediterranean, and will be supported by the already-existing French Hub.

In this context, the **Hellenic Centre for Marine Research (HCMR)**, coordinator for the development of the Greek Hub for BE, will be responsible for implementing efficiently the Hub's activities at a national level, from the launch up to the operation phase. Among the responsibilities of the Hub members will be the networking and strategic decisions in line with PELAGOS Cluster guidelines.
